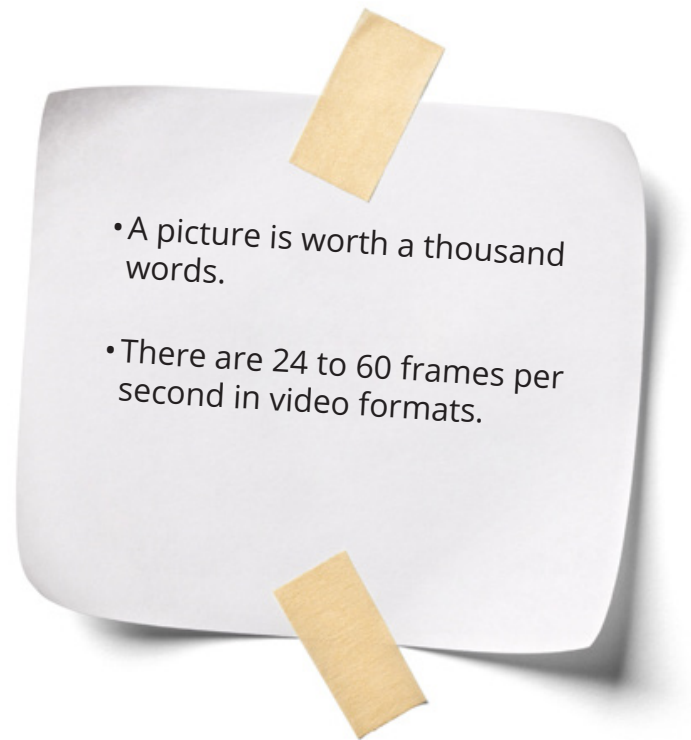
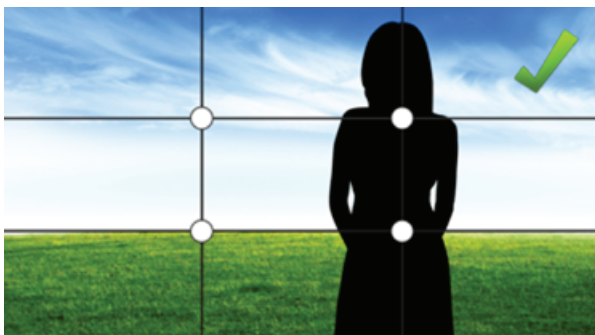
INTRODUCTION

Recording videos on mobile devices has been getting very easy recently. Faculty can use their mobile devices to record interviews with colleagues during professional conferences, interviews with practitioners, field trips, natural phenomena, live events, and breaking news. Some of the content can be used effectively in your online courses.

A CLOSER LOOK

Here are the tips for recording video on mobile devices:

- Tip 1: Always hold your mobile device in landscape position.
- Tip 2: When the situation permits, make sure shooting subject has enough lighting and quality audio.
- Tip 3: Hold your mobile still. Try not to pan your camera. Compose your frame before the shooting.
- Tip 4: Position yourself not too far away and not too close.
- Tip 5: Try to record consent on video during the shooting.
